Enthronement of Archbishop Cherry Vann - Saturday 8th November




We are delighted to announce the date of the enthronement service which marks the celebration of our 15th Archbishop of Wales, The Most Reverend Cherry Vann.

Following her election at Electoral College and the Sacred Synod and Consecration services at the end of July, we can now confirm that Archbishop Cherry will be enthroned at Newport Cathedral on **Saturday 8th November**.

Plans are underway and further details will be announced in due course. It will be a ticket only event but will be live streamed so everyone can watch the enthronement as it happens.

Please continue to pray for Archbishop Cherry as she prepares to begin her ministry across the province of Wales and for the Diocese of Monmouth at this time of new beginnings.

Sunday Themes



Two of the branches of our Diocesan vision are 'Equality and Diversity' and 'Social Justice' and we wanted to draw your attention to two weeks where there are suggested themes for Sunday worship.



Disability awareness Sunday is on 28th September (although it can be done any Sunday you wish!). This year's theme reminds us that every person, disabled or not, reflects the image of God.

The most important thing about Disability Awareness Sunday is that Christians reach out and include disabled people fully in community life.

Jesus welcomed everyone. Let's follow His example and open our doors – and hearts – wider. The 2025 Disability Awareness Sunday resource explores 1 Samuel 16:7 'God looks at the heart', and being 'Made in God's Image'.

Clare Bradly explains why she is looking for volunteers to help out at the <u>Usk</u> <u>Show</u> on **13th September**.

"We have run a chaplaincy tent at the Usk Show each year since 2016.

The chaplaincy service provides free tea, coffee, squash, and cakes, together with baby changing and feeding facilities, children's play activities and a space to sit. There are also people available for a quiet chat if anyone needs that.

The tent is open from 8:00am until 5:00pm and we rely on volunteers to cover this period, so if you would like to help, even if you can only spare an hour or a two during this time please do get in touch. We just need to have enough volunteers to help us manage



visitors to the tent during the course of the day.

If you think this might be something you would like to participate in, we are looking for people to help serve refreshments, plus people to work with children when they are there, and also a team of clergy or lay people available just to talk to our visitors. It is not intended that these roles should be especially evangelising, it is just being alongside people."




